ABOUT ASSAM CANCER CARE FOUNDATION

Assam Cancer Care Foundation (ACCF) is a joint initiative of the Government of Assam and the Tata Trusts, established to create the largest three-tiered cancer care network in South Asia. The initiative aims to make quality cancer care accessible and affordable across Northeast India and neighbouring countries by bringing comprehensive cancer services closer to patients' homes.

Under this initiative, seventeen cancer care hospitals are being established across different districts of Assam. In April 2022, the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, dedicated seven hospitals to the nation at Dibrugarh, Barpeta, Tezpur, Lakhimpur, Jorhat, Kokrajhar, and Darrang. In March 2024, two additional hospitals at Silchar and Guwahati were inaugurated by Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam.

Further expanding the network, three hospitals were inaugurated in March 2026 at Tinsukia,

Golaghat, and Diphu. With these additions, twelve cancer care hospitals are now operational across the state. Construction of the remaining hospitals at Sivasagar, Nagaon, Dhubri, Goalpara, and Nalbari is progressing at various stages.

ACCF hospitals are equipped with state-of-the-art cancer treatment facilities and modern diagnostic services. The network is digitally integrated through the Digital Nerve Centre (DiNC), established at the State Cancer Institute (SCI), Guwahati, enabling coordinated and connected cancer care.

ACCF, in collaboration with the Government of Assam, is also strengthening the continuum of cancer care through community-based initiatives focused on awareness, prevention, early detection, optimal treatment, and palliative care. By leveraging the existing healthcare system and ACCF's capabilities, the initiative is advancing the vision of comprehensive, equitable, and patient-centred cancer care for the people of Assam.

About ACCF NURSING COLLEGES BARPETA | LAKHIMPUR

ACCF Nursing Colleges have been established to enhance healthcare education and address the need for skilled healthcare professionals in Assam. This initiative supports the broader goal of improving healthcare infrastructure and services in the state.

MISSION AND VISION

MISSION

To produce knowledgeable, competent nurses with clear critical thinking skills who are caring, motivated, assertive, and well-disciplined responding to the changing needs of profession, healthcare delivery system and society.

VISION

To prepare nurses who can make independent decisions in nursing situations within the scope of practice, to protect the rights of individuals and groups, to conduct research in nursing practice to apply evidence-based practice.

ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The minimum age for admission is 17 years as on 31 December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.
- Candidates must have passed the 12th Standard (10+2) examination in the Science stream from a recognised Board/Council, with a minimum of 45% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology. The candidates must have pass marks in English.
- Candidates are also eligible from the State Open School recognised by the State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognised by Central Government, having Science subjects and English only.
- All admissions to the course will be made only through the Common Entrance Examination conducted by Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences, Assam.
- All genders can apply.

RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR **SC / ST / OBC / PWD / EWS**

Admissions under the reserved quota will be subject to the reservation policy and eligibility criteria for SC / ST / OBC / PwD / EWS as prescribed by the Central Government and State Government as applicable.

 9. Permanent Resident Certificate
 10. Medical Fitness Certificate from Registered Medical Office
 11. PwD candidates to submit disability certificate

MODE OF PAYMENT:

The fee should be paid at the time of admission through online transfer or by Demand Draft drawn on any bank, in favour of "ASSAM CANCER CARE FOUNDATION", payable at Barpeta/Lakhimpur.

Payment of fees in cash will not be accepted in any circumstances.

UGC NOTIFICATION ON “REMITTANCE AND REFUND OF FEES AND OTHER CENTRIC ISSUES”

- Verification and Non retention of Students Academic and Personal testimonials
- No Institution of Higher Education (HEI) shall insist upon a student to submit the original academic and personal certificates and testimonials like mark sheets, school leaving certificates and, other such documents at the time of submitting admission form.
- ACCF Nursing Colleges will physically verify the original documents at the time of admission of the student in his / her presence and return them immediately after satisfying themselves about their authenticity and veracity, keeping the self-attested copies for their record.
- The self-attested testimonials of students shall be held valid and authentic by institution concerned and/or the affiliating university for all purposes and administrative requirements and should there be a need for physical verification at any time during the course of programme of study, such verification shall be undertaken in the presence of the student and certificates and testimonials thus verified shall be returned immediately to the student.
- Taking the certificates and testimonials into institutional custody under any circumstances or pretexts is strictly prohibited for it is a coercive tactic which can be misused for blackmailing students who wish to withdraw admission from the institute for better prospects or other compulsions.
- In case of any suspicion over the authenticity or genuineness of the testimonials, the reference may be made to the university or the board which issues certificates to the student and the admission be subjected to the authentication, but original certificates shall not be retained under any circumstances.

REMITTANCE AND REFUND OF FEES AND OTHER CENTRIC ISSUES

- ACCF Nursing Colleges will not make it mandatory for applicants to purchase the institutional prospectus any time during the programme of study. Purchasing prospectus shall be the personal choice of the student and he / she has all rights to decide against it in case he / she wishes to access the information from institutional website. As laid down in the UGC Guidelines on students' entitlement, ACCF will disclose on their website and prospectus information like the status of the institution, its affiliation, accreditation rating, physical assets and amenities, course-wise sanctioned intake of students, details of faculty, membership of governing bodies and minutes of the meetings of bodies like Academic / Executive council, sources of income and the financial situation and any other information about its functioning necessary for a student to make a fully informed choice.
- ACCF Nursing Colleges will charge fees in advance only for the semester / year in which a student is to engage in academic activities. Collecting advance fees for entire programme of study or for more than one semester / year in which a student is enrolled is strictly prohibited as it restricts the student from exercising other options of enrolment elsewhere. This enabling provision is in line with the UGC guidelines on Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) and Model Curriculum which are geared towards promoting a student's inter institutional mobility.
- If a student chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following system according to UGC Guidelines for the refund of fees remitted by the student:

CATEGORY	PERCENTAGE OF REFUND AGGREGATE FEE*	POINT OF TIME WHEN NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL IS SERVED TO THE INSTITUTION
1	100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
2	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
3	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission
4	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after formally notified last date of admission
5	0%	More than 30 days after formally- notified last date of admission

- (Inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of security deposit)
- In case of (i) in the table above, ACCF Nursing Colleges will deduct an amount not more than 10% of the aggregate fees as processing charges from the refundable amount.
- Fees shall be refunded by ACCF BNC to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving a written application from him/her in this regard.

WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS AFTER THE FIRST OR SUBSEQUENT YEAR

- If a student withdraws after first year or later due to any reason whatsoever, clearance certificate would only be given to her after ensuring the following:

- » **Admission Fee** - No Refund
- » **Security Deposit** - To be adjusted against tuition fee for balance period of the four-year course.
- » **Student Association fees** - No Refund.
- » **Tuition Fees** - To be charged for the balance period of the entire four-year course.
- » **Hostel Charges** - Room rent for complete duration of the four-year course to be charged.
- » **Mess Fees** - As per actual. A single day of the month will be treated as a month.
- » **Other Charges** - As per actual. A single day of the month will be treated as a month.

COURSE CURRICULUM

The B.Sc. Nursing programme is a comprehensive four-year curriculum structured into eight semesters utilising a credit and semester-based system. The programme features a competency-based approach emphasising ten core

competencies fundamental to nursing practice. While the core and foundational courses are mandatory, students have the flexibility to choose from elective courses.

- All students are required to attend both theory and practical classes regularly with a minimum attendance of 85% for theory classes and 100% for clinical sessions in accordance with INC guidelines.
- Students who fail to maintain at least 75% attendance will be ineligible to appear for the final examinations conducted by Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences (SSHUS) and Assam Nursing Council (ANC).
- Each student is responsible for the proper handling and safe custody of any apparatus or equipment they use.
- In the event of damage or loss to college property due to misuse or negligence, the student will be required to cover the costs of repair or replacement.
- Students are granted a six-week vacation each year. During this period, parents or local guardians are responsible for taking their ward from the hostel and dropping them back after the vacation. Any absence due to illness or other reasons for returning later than the scheduled date will need to be compensated for by extending the training period accordingly, either during or at the end of the course.

GUARDIANSHIP

- **Legal Guardian:** The name, address and telephone number of the legal guardian must be clearly provided in the application form. In the absence of parents, a senior blood relative of the candidate may be designated as the legal guardian.
- **Local Guardian:** The name, relationship, address, and telephone number of the local guardian must be clearly provided in the application form.

DISMISSAL (IN CASE OF)

- **Overnight Stay / Leave / Remaining Out of Hostel Premises:** Students must adhere to the scheduled times for returning to the hostel. Any overnight stay, leave, or remaining out of the hostel premises beyond the scheduled time requires prior permission from the hostel authorities.
- **Misconduct:** Any form of misconduct, whether occurring within or outside the college campus will be subject to disciplinary action.
- **Interference with Authority:** Any interference with the decisions of the authority regarding matters related to the smooth administration of the college will not be tolerated.

ANTI RAGGING MEASURES AND RULES

- **Ragging Prevention:** The institute has implemented various precautions in accordance with UGC directives to ensure a 100% ragging-free campus.
- **Anti-Ragging Committee:** The Anti-Ragging Committee is composed of senior faculty members, hostel warden and student representatives, and is chaired by the Chairperson.
- **Committee Actions:** The committee has implemented various measures and assigned responsibilities to staff members across the college to effectively prevent ragging.

ADMISSION CANCELLATION POLICY

- **Admission Policy:** If a candidate enrolls and pays the requisite fees on time but fails to join the respective course within 10 days from the commencement of the session without prior notice, the concerned authority may, at its discretion, cancel the admission. The fees paid will be non-refundable.
- **Admission Cancellation:** Admission may be cancelled if the applicant submits any false / incorrect / incomplete information to the authority
